Divine Service Speaker: Pastor Kelan Jovan Fielder

Sermon title: “It Was A Setup!”

Scripture: Genesis 50:20



Pastor Kelan Jovan Fielder is the 2nd Son of Kris and Demetria Fielder, and from the age of 2 was raised in Pine Forge, PA. As a child he attended Pine Forge Elementary and Pine Forge Academy. He later went to Oakwood College, now Oakwood University, where he majored in theology. While at Oakwood, he was offered sponsorship from the Allegheny East Conference to attend the Andrews University Theological Seminary. There, he met Pranitha (Pruh-nee-thuh) Pilli (Pil-lee), and they married June 21, 2009. At the beginning of 2010, Kelan received his first assignment from the AEC Conference to be an assistant Pastor at the Emmanuel Brinklow SDA Church under the leadership of Dr. Tony Medley, and Pranitha received her assignment from the Potomac Conference of SDA to be the youth and young adult pastor at the Sligo SDA Church under the leadership of Pastor Charles Tapp. In 2015 Kelan was reassigned to the Fourth Street Friendship SDA Church in Washington, DC as the sole pastor. In 2017 while pastoring at 4th Street, Kelan and Pranitha had their only child Azzan (Uh-Zahn), who will be in kindergarten this fall. On Feb.15, 2020, after 10 years of pastoring in the AEC, the Lord gave Kelan another assignment, and he has been walking by faith since accepting the call.

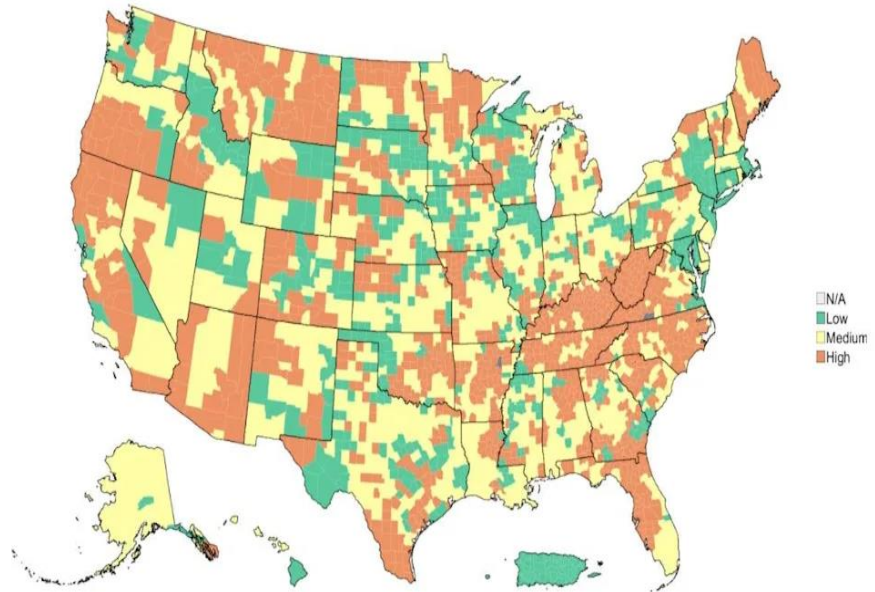
